As we near the end of the year, I reflect back on some of the things God has blessed me with throughout this past year. God has blessed me with good health. My family and the Chinese congregation have been blessed through your prayers and support. I am very thankful to all of you for your support throughout the year.

Due to your support for the past 30 years, our Chinese work is still surviving in San Francisco and we have been teaching the sound doctrine from the Bible to many of the lost souls here in San Francisco. Our work is not only surviving, but also standing firm in such a city as San Francisco. Your support brings the Good News to many people, young and old, in San Francisco and to many of the Chinese speakers throughout Asia.

In our neighborhood, there are several other religious churches who meet just a few doors down from our meeting place. When our congregation comes together every Sunday, we come together to worship our Lord. These other religious churches see something different about our church. They see that we are growing and that we have filled up a building that used to be empty, but is now full of people who love God. This makes an impact on the community around us. We now have several regular visitors who worship together with us who lived in the neighborhood and noticed that we were meeting every Sunday. They originally wanted to find out more about us, but now they come every Sunday to worship together with us.

People in the community see that we meet every Sunday and they can see our strong Faith. They can see the light in the City. Because of your support, we are able to stand firm as a light to the community. Because of your support, our congregation has been able to restore the Columbia Heights (CH) congregation. When we first came to the CH congregation, there were very few members and it seemed as if they were ready to throw in the towel and close up the doors. The Chinese Radio program has continued to strive. Listeners continue to send questions and request Bibles. We also want to print our own books to send to our listeners, so that they can study on their own. Please continue to support the radio program.

The planning for starting a Chinese Preaching School program is currently being postponed, since Bro. Bill Estep passed away. We will see what God has in stored for the future. Please continue to pray for the Chinese Preaching School.

Our congregation's Youth program has continued to be very fruitful. The younger generation is now preaching more often. We are also training the Columbia Heights congregation to get their young men to preach as well. Our goal is to help them grow their own young preachers to be able to be ready to serve as preachers in 2 to 3 years. Our goal is to also train the young men from the Westside congregation to be able to preach for our congregation.
