### Update on the Reeves.

The Millers' arrival in Rwanda has illuminated a miscommunication to the Reeves and Millers about Rwandan immigration policies. They had planned to spend the first six months learning the language and then obtain their work visas. This week they found out that they had been informed incorrectly, and the work visas must be in place within 15 days of their arrival. In addition, some agreements need to be in place before visa application can be initiated. The Millers are scrambling to bring this all together, and we are praying that the government will not require them to leave Rwanda while their visas are sorted out. Dave, the Columbus mission committee chairman and a Columbus elder will travel to Rwanda on February 17 for nine days to set this in motion for the Reeves family. We do not know how long this will delay the family's departure, but pray it will only be a couple of weeks. Please pray for these arrangements to go smoothly, and for wisdom for all parties. ~Sandi Gray

### Transition Team News

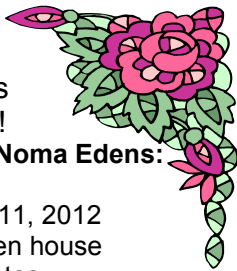
