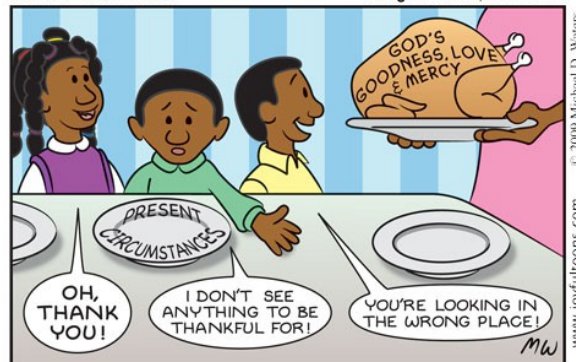
Save the Date!
